Motor starts, but does not pump any water	Pump impeller is above water level and needs priming	Turn the pump on for a few seconds, then off and back on again three or four times. This will fill the impeller chamber with water and prime the pump. - or - Position pump below water level or in at least $3^{1}/_{4}$ " of water.



Thank you for purchasing this Danner product. This versatile pump is suitable for home use including basement pumpouts, pool and pond draining. The included adapters attach to standard 3/4" garden hose or 11/2" pool hose. The bottom-draw screened intake measures 8" in diameter and fits into most pool drains and pumps down to 1/8".

It incorporates a high efficiency vortex impeller and sealed bearings to provide energy savings while maintaining high output.

This pump must be used fully or partially submersed. Note that it will continue pumping water until the water level is approximately $1/_8$ inch deep. Never run this pump dry.



ELECTRICAL PRECAUTIONS

Always use a properly grounded outlet. Do not immerse the plug in water. DO NOT REACH INTO THE WATER TO REMOVE THE PLUG. TURN OFF CIRCUIT FIRST. A "drip loop" in the cords should be used. A "drip loop" is a loop in the cord below the level of the receptacle or plug that prevents water from traveling along the cord. The national Electric Code requires that a ground fault interrupter circuit (GFCI) be installed in every branch circuit supplying the fountain or pond equipment. Your dealer can supply GFCI units. NEVER REMOVE GROUND PIN FROM PLUG.

WARNING - Risk of electric shock - This pump is supplied with a grounding conductor and grounding-type attachment plug. To reduce the risk of electric shock, be certain that it is connected only to a properly grounded, grounding-type receptacle.

WARNING: FOR YOUR PROTECTION, ALWAYS UNPLUG THE UNIT FROM ITS POWER SOURCE BEFORE INSTALLING OR SERVICING. DO NOT REACH, REMOVE OR DISASSEMBLE BEFORE YOU DISCONNECT POWER.

Operation Precautions

Never run pump dry. Only use this pump with clean water. It is not intended to move water with large non-dissolved solids. Never use pump for liquids other than water. This pump is not for continuous use; it is rated for intermittent use.

Operation Instructions

Make certain that all electrical connections have a GFCI installed. Attach hoses using Teflon tape on fittings. This will aid in future disassembly.


This pump will start immediately when completely submerged or

when used in at least $3^{1}/4^{\prime\prime}$ of water. In less than $3^{1}/4^{\prime\prime}$ the pump must be primed first. Do this by turning the pump on for a few seconds, then off and back on again three or four times. This will fill the impeller chamber with water and prime the pump.

The included adapters can be used to connect directly to 3/4'' garden hose or most standard $1^{1}/{2''}$ pool hoses.


Check all connections before activating power to the pump.

Always keep the Intake Screen clean.



Maintenance:

This pump does not require any lubrication or special maintenance. Remove and rinse the Intake Screen ① as needed.



Periodically cleaning the impeller will maintain pump performance and extend pump life.

To clean impeller follow these steps:

- 1) Completely disconnect pump from power supply.
- 2) Remove hoses and bring pump to clear work area.
- 3) Remove 4 base screws and remove pump base (A).
- 4) Clean impeller (B) with a brush and fresh water only, never any solvents.
- 5) Clean O-ring (and surrounding areas on both motor housing and motor cover (, then re-attach cover () with screws.

Impeller should not be removed during normal maintenance.
