

Blue Line Products

ASP Blue Line products pay tribute to the critical role that law enforcement plays in protecting citizens in our society. The police are said to be the "thin blue line" that protects the public and maintains order.

Blue Line products are used to express support of the police. They are sometimes carried to commemorate officers who have been killed in the line of duty. The thin blue line symbolizes the relationship of law enforcement with the community it protects from victimization.

The term "thin blue line" was first used in referring to the police by LAPD Chief Bill Parker in the 1950s. In a department produced television show, Parker explained that the purpose of the police was to serve as a barrier (a thin blue line) between the public and anarchy.
