ALFA STARTER REVOLVER IS NOT A FIREARM

The ALFA starter revolvers are chambered in .22 caliber **blank**, .32 S&W **blank**, or 209 primer.

The ALFA starter revolver **IS NOT A FIREARM** in that it is specifically designed to be incapable of firing a projectile - a bullet.

It is, however, a carefully designed and manufactured product built with the quality materials and precision production processes common to quality firearms manufacturers.

Used as intended - as a starter revolver for sporting events, as a training aid for hunting dogs, or as an aid for firearms safety programs - **and given proper care and maintenance, it should deliver years of service.**

Clean the Alfa thoroughly before using it for the first time.

GENERAL SAFETY WARNINGS

While your starter revolver is not a functioning firearm, always keep two things in mind. First, it is designed to discharge a powder charge, which involves high pressure and a loud, sharp noise. Second, others could misapprehend it as a firearm. Therefore you should **always follow traditional firearms handling safety precautions.**

ALWAYS REMOVE ALL BLANK CARTRIDGES AFTER USE and clean your starter revolver and store it without any cartridges in it.

ALWAYS WEAR EYE AND EAR PROTECTION when using your starter revolver. Good impact resistant shooting glasses can protect your eyes in many circumstances when injury would result without them. Hearing protection minimizes or eliminates the cumulative and permanent hearing loss that results from unprotected exposure to gunfire.

NEVER DISCHARGE YOUR STARTER REVOLVER IN CLOSE PROXIMITY TO ANYONE ELSE unless they are well behind the revolver. Your starter revolver is designed similarly to any revolvers and there is a risk of hot gasses and gunpowder particles being discharged from the side of the revolver upon firing.

NEVER MIX ALCOHOL OR DRUGS WITH YOUR USE OF YOUR STARTER REVOLVER. It is unsafe.

BE CAREFUL WHEN LOADING OR UNLOADING YOUR STARTER REVOLVER. It uses ammunition that can be potentially susceptible to discharge from a sharp blow.

NEVER LEAVE YOUR STARTER REVOLVER UNATTENDED IF IT IS LOADED WITH CARTRIDGES. Store your starter revolver unloaded and separately from any cartridges.

NEVER ATTEMPT TO LOAD "LIVE" AMMUNITION (normal .22 or .32 caliber cartridges with bullets) INTO YOUR STARTER REVOLVER. While the cylinder is designed to prevent loading of "normal" cartridges, there is a risk of accidental discharge and injury to you, to bystanders, or damage to the starter revolver if you attempt to load live ammunition.

AMMUNITION WARNING

Your starter revolver is designed to operate with only factory manufactured blank ammunition. In the .22 caliber model **DO NOT ATTEMPT TO LOAD OR DISCHARGE NAIL GUN CARTRIDGES. THE USE OF NAIL GUN CARTRIDGES IN THIS REVOLVER INVOKES A HIGH RISK OF SERIOUS INJURY TO THE SHOOTER AND BYSTANDERS AND CAN PERMANENTLY DAMAGE OR RUIN THE REVOLVER.**

NAIL GUN CARTRIDGES MANUFACTURERS ALSO WARN AGAINST SHOOTING NAIL GUN CARTRIDGES IN STARTER REVOLVERS.

OPERATION OF YOUR STARTER REVOLVER

Your starter revolver operates very similarly to a standard double action revolver. To load your starter revolver, press the cylinder release latch on the left side of the frame forward, freeing the cylinder to swing out from the frame. Load the cylinder chambers with new factory manufactured blank cartridges. Your ALFA starter revolver is chambered for .22 caliber blank, 32 S&W blank, or 209 primer.

LOAD YOUR REVOLVER ONLY WITH THE TYPE OF CARTRIDGES THAT ARE INSCRIBED ON THE SIDE OF THE REVOLVER'S BARREL!

After loading the chambers, snap the cylinder back into the frame. Your starter revolver is designed with an automatic internal safety. The trigger is inoperable unless the cylinder is engaged in the frame. Once the cylinder is loaded and engaged in the frame, the starter revolver is intended to only fire from a sustained pull on the trigger. The starter revolver can be fire: "double action" by a sustained pull on the trigger when the hammer is in its "at rest" position, down against the frame. The revolver can also be fire "single action" by first cocking the hammer and then applying pressure to the trigger.

MAINTAINING YOUR STARTER REVOLVER

Like all other revolvers, your starter revolver should be cleaned after every 50 rounds or after each training session before storing it.

This consists of using standard firearms cleaning products to clean the chambers of the cylinder; cylinder base pin (extractor rod), and the external surfaces of the revolver.

After cleaning the surfaces of the revolver and the inner surfaces of the chambers, apply a light coat of fine gun oil. Use no more than a drop or two of oil on the hammer, trigger and cylinder base pin (extractor rod). Excessive use of oil can result in buildup of residue and eventual malfunction of your starter revolver.

DO NOT ATTEMPT DISASSEMBLY OF YOUR STARTER REVOLVER!

The inner working parts of the revolver are not intended for user maintenance as fitting and adjustment of those parts requires professional training.

FACTORY SERVICE

Alfa-Proj will provide service or repair for your starter revolver in the event of problems due to use, deterioration or breakage of parts. Simply return your starter revolver **unloaded!** to:

Please include a letter explaining the problem. **Include your telephone number** or other way to contact you. Our customer service staff will contact you, explain the costs of repair and arrange repairs and return shipping of your starter revolver.

LIMITED LIFETIME WARRANTY

In addition to offering repair and service, Alfa-Proj warrants to the original purchaser that the product is free from defects in materials and workmanship under normal use. Damage due to abuse, misuse, neglect or unauthorized adjustments or modifications made or attempted by anyone other than the above stated factory repair service is excluded from this warranty. The Lifetime Service Policy covers functional defects.

Alfa-Proj will repair or replace, at its option, any defects due to faulty materials or workmanship.

The condition of this warranty is twofold:

First, the purchaser must return the warranty card with proof of retail purchase to:

Second, the purchaser must notify Elite Custom Guns service department, in writing or by e-mail (elitecustomguns@gmail.com) stating the difficulty experienced and the date and place of original purchase.

Excluded from this warranty are malfunctions caused by misuse or abuse of the starter revolver, damage due to lack of proper cleaning and maintenance, unauthorized modification, adjustments, or repairs, shipping damages, careless handling, normal wear and tear, and defective or improperly loaded ammunition and corrosion.

Alfa-Proj's responsibility under this warranty is limited to the repair or replacement of the revolver. Responsibility or liability for damage to property other than the revolver, personal injury or death, or consequential damages is **SPECIFICALLY EXCLUDED**.

The starter revolver is sold by Trail Blazin' Innovations with the explicit understanding that we are not responsible for personal injury or property damage caused by improper use or accidental discharge due to conditions or circumstances beyond our control, loss or use of defective products or for other consequential or incidental damages. Nor are we responsible for the legality of its resale.

This warranty is in full compliance with the Magnuson-Moss Federal Trade Commission Improvement Act, Public Law No. 93-637 (July 4th, 1973). This warranty gives you specific legal rights. You may have other rights pursuant to state laws, which vary from state to state.
