


Air Volume Control

Installation Instructions

Your Brady Air Volume Control is made of the finest materials available, and design to offer you trouble-free service. Please follow the instructions for installation carefully to insure maximum performance from this quality Brady product.

- 1. Check the system for leaks. Your Air Volume Control will not replenish enough air to overcome leaks in the system.
- 2. Make sure that the side of the control marked "tank side" is closest to the tank. The control will not function otherwise.
- 3. Your Brady Air Volume Control should be installed into the 1/4" or 3/8" N.P.T. tank port above and closest to the discharge port as shown below.
- 4. Connecting the tubing (vacuum line) to the suction port located at the center of the control and the suction port on the pump. You Air Volume Control works on a vacuum principle, so make sure that the tubing connected to the pump is clear and not obstructed or kinked.
- 5. A snug fit is all that is necessary for all connections. Do not over tighten!
- 6. For best results and easy installation, use the Brady UK-1 Installation kit.
