

Installation

- 1. Disconnect the vehicles antenna from behind the radio.
- Connect the male antenna lead from the FM modulator to the radio.
 Note: An antenna adapter may be needed, if so please see your nearest Metra dealer for the correct antenna adapter.
- Connect the female antenna lead from the FM modulator to the antenna coming out from the dash. Note: An antenna adapter may be needed, if so please see your nearest Metra dealer for the correct antenna adapter.
- 4. Connect the Black wire from the FM modulator to ground.
- **5.** Connect the **Red** wire to a 12-volt accessory wire, one that has 12-volts when the key is turned to the "On" position.
 - **Optional:** Instead of connecting the **Red** wire straight to a 12-volt accessory wire, you can put a toggle switch in line with the **Red** wire. This will allow the user to manually turn the FM modulator on and off. The toggle switch must be put in-between the inline fuse holder and the FM modulator.
- **6.** Connect the RCA audio jacks from the source that you want to go through the radio to the RCA jacks on the side of the FM modulator.
- 7. Select the FM modulator frequency on the side of the modulator that you want to use, either 87.9 MHz or 88.3 MHz.

Operation

- 1. Turn the key on
- 2. Turn on the radio and tune it to the frequency that you selected.
- 3. Turn on the audio source that you want to play through the radio.
- 4. Adjust the volume on the audio source. The FM modulator is "auto sensing," and will automatically turn on when there is sufficient audio present on the RCA jacks. Note: The volume on the audio source may need to be set at 60% to 70% in order to turn on the FM modulator. The optional toggle switch will prevent the FM modulator from interrupting your radio until the toggle switch is placed in the "ON" position.
- **5.** Adjust the volume on the radio to a comfortable listening level.

Troubleshooting

No sound

- Make sure audio source is playing and check the volume setting on the audio source. Note: The volume on the audio source may need to be set at 60% to 70% in order to turn on the FM modulator. Check the volume setting on the radio.
- Make sure the FM modulator Red wire has 12-volts on it when the key is in the "On" position.
- Make sure the radio is on the frequency selected on the modulator.
- If using the optional toggle switch, make sure the toggle switch is in the "On" position.

Stations bleed through what you are listening to

- Make sure the radio is on the frequency selected on the modulator.
- Try switching the modulator frequency.
