
All Vehicles

- Carefully unclip and remove the climate controls. (Figure A)
- 2. Remove two Phillips screws from the bottom of the radio and remove. (Figure B)
- 3. Remove the four Torx screws from the subdash bracket and remove. (Figure C)


Note: The bottom screw holes will be where our kit will attach to.

- **5.** Cut or file the edges of the climate controls as shown. (Figure E, F)




- Mount the radio to the supplied double DIN brackets using screws supplied with the radio.
- 2. Locate the factory wiring harness in the dash.

 Metra recommends using the proper mating
 adapters from Metra and Axxess to intergrate
 your new radio. Re-connect the negative terminal
 and test the unit for proper operation.
- 3. Mount the radio into the dash. (Figure A)
- Place the climate controls into the opening below the new radio and push it back as far as it will go, without damaging the dash. (Figure B)
- 5. Push the included snaps onto the legs on the top of the double DIN trim plate.
- Snap the double DIN trim plate over the radio and use the supplied 1/2" screws to screw into the dash at the bottom. (Figure C)


