## Balloon Weight Tips:

- When a cluster of balloons is sold, properly anchor them by tying each ribbon to a weight separately. If the balloons become loose from the weight they will float away individually. DO NOT tie ribbons together before attaching to weight.
- For Foil Balloons - If the balloon weight has a sticky tab we recommend attaching the sticky tab to the opposite side of the inflation opening on the balloon tail. If the balloon weight does not have a sticky tab, tie the ribbon to balloon tail below the inflation opening.
- Attach a balloon weight before you inflate the balloon so it will be held down if it is released.
