OPERATING YOUR COMMERCIAL TANNING BED

CAUTION: <u>BEFORE</u> Initial Use, Cycle Timer One Complete Session To Insure Proper Operation.

The SunMaster commercial unit is equipped with an onboard timer (excluding SM-32MCX). This timer is used to pre-select the actual tanning time. Make sure shorting plug is connected to the timer port in the back of the unit. After timer is set, lie on the acrylic surface of the lounge and switch the ON/OFF power switch on the airbar to the ON position, and lower the canopy.

NOTE: The switch on the airbar may be used to interrupt the tanning session at any time by pushing it to the OFF position.

WARNING

- ❖ Do not cover the ventilation holes on the unit.
- ❖ Do not look directly at the lamps, even if wearing protective eyewear.
- Sunglasses are not suitable. Always wear the proper eye protection goggles.
- ❖ Do not reset the timer beyond the recommended exposure schedule.
- ❖ Do not tan more than once within a 24-hour period.
- ❖ Do not use tanning bed in any place that is likely to come in contact with water.
- ❖ Do not use this unit without first consulting your physician if you are taking any medications (especially photo sensitive drugs), are pregnant, or believe yourself to be particularly sensitive to the sun.
- Consult you physician before using your tanning bed if you are diabetic, epileptic, prone to fainting or very sensitive to sunlight.
- Keep children away from tanning unit.
- Use only lamps specified for your tanning system.
- ❖ Do not use excessive amounts of water, any abrasive cleaners, or any spray cleaner that is not specifically designed for use with acrylic surfaces.

The SunMaster Series is in conformity with performance standards for sunlamp products Title 21 CFR, Part 1010 and 1040.20 only if all replacement lamps, protective eyewear and all electrical parts will be replaced with the same as initially installed by the manufacturer or an approved equivalent.

CARE AND CLEANING

CAUTION: The tanning bed should be disconnected from the power supply before cleaning or disinfecting the inside of the acrylic. Avoid water or solution entering the lamp compartment.

Failure To Clean Acrylics, Fans, And The Inside Of Your Tanning Bed Could Void The Warranty.

After each session is completed, spray the acrylic surface with the specially formulated UVT (Ultraviolet Transmitting) acrylic cleaner according to the instructions. **Do not use alcohol or ammonia**. Wipe the surface of the acrylic with a clean cloth. The acrylic should never be wiped with a dry cloth, as this will generate a slight charge that will attract dust.

For maximum efficiency of your tanning bed, periodic cleaning of lamps, reflectors, acrylics, fans and the inside of the unit is required.

WARNING:

If you have been diagnosed by a physician as being allergic to the sun or are currently taking photosensitive medications consult your physician before using this product.

Certain drugs – particularly those designed to enhance photosensitivity – may cause individuals under their influence to experience adverse effects. These people should avoid exposure to UV sources of all kinds. Doctors will advise persons taking these drugs of possible adverse effects.

It is recommended that only one person at a time tan in the tanning bed. Protective eyewear is provided with each tanning bed. Use protective eyewear when using this equipment.

Occasionally, persons using the tanning system will experience a slight reddening of the skin – usually in small patches – after the second or third session. This redness is often accompanied by an itching sensation. This is usually nothing more than a heat 'rash' caused by heat from the lamps within the system. It is generally very limited and caused by constant contact of the skin with the acrylic surface. It should go away within 24 hours and should not reappear. This rash can be lessened or prevented by turning over occasionally during tanning sessions, and by applying moisturizing lotion to the affected area after the tanning session is completed.

CAUTION

WHILE THERE IS NO IMMEDIATE CLINICAL EVIDENCE REGARDING UVA EXPOSURE AND ITS EFFECTS UPON EXPECTANT MOTHERS, IT IS STRONGLY ADVISED THAT EXPECTANT MOTHERS BE DISCOURAGED FROM USING THE TANNING BED.

EXPOSURE TIMES AND FREQUENCIES

Melanin, the brownish pigment produced by special cells in the base layer of the skin, determines the individual's ability to tan. As the skin is exposed to ultraviolet rays, the melanin is activated and combines with protein cells that rise to the skin's surface, thus producing a tan. The amount of melanin in your body determines how quickly and darkly you tan.

THE TAN PRODUCED BY THE TANNING BED IS A DEEP, RICH "COSMETIC" TAN. HOWEVER, REGARDLESS OF HOW MUCH AN INDIVIDUAL MAY TAN WITH THIS UNIT, IT WILL NOT PROVIDE ADEQUATE PROTECTION AGAINST OVEREXPOSURE TO NATURAL SUNLIGHT OR UVB TANNING SYSTEMS.

SKIN TYPE II-	USUALLY BURNS EASILY AND SEVERELY, TANS MINIMALLY OR LIGHTLY

ACRYLIC REMOVAL/RE-LAMPING INSTRUCTIONS

CAUTION: REPLACE ONLY WITH THE LAMP SPECIFIED ON THE WARNING LABEL (located on the tanning unit), OR RECOGNIZED EQUIVALENT.

- 1. Disconnect unit from power supply.
- 2. Remove acrylic from unit by removing the screws on the front acrylic retaining strip. Back strip remains in place do not remove screws.
- 3. For bench, carefully lift acrylic upward and out. For canopy, pull downward and out.
- 4. Clean acrylic shield. (Refer: CARE AND CLEANING.) Clean both sides of acrylic shield. Novus Products recommended.
- 5. To remove lamps, twist ½ turn until pins in the lamp line up with the slots in the lamp holder.
- 6. To install lamp, align pins on lamp with slots. Twist ½ turn to lock in place. For reflector lamps, the label on the lamp MUST be fully visible.
- 7. Insert acrylic into back retaining strip channel. Reinstall front strip with screws. Reconnect unit to power supply.

SHOCKS (Gas Springs) INSTALLATION

The shocks MUST be installed with the thick barrel <u>UP</u> and the thin shaft (plunger) <u>DOWN</u>. If they are installed incorrectly, this will cause the seals in the barrel to fail and **void** the warranty.

#### Leg Installation


Place lounge face down, on blanket or carpet.

Remove hardware from 5/16" bolts extended from frame.


Place center hole of leg over the center 5/16" bolt in frame.

Replace hardware.

Do not tighten until all hardware is in place on one leg. Flex the end of leg and fit over end bolts; add hardware. Tighten all hardware securely; repeat for other end. (Hardware= flat washer, lock washer, and 5/16" nut)



Remove hardware from mounting bracket in bed frame. Attach hinges as shown in drawing below. DO NOT tighten bolts at this time.



#### Canopy Installation


Move canopy into the position shown (will require two (2) persons). Mounting brackets on canopy fit inside hinge bars.

Insert pins through bracket first then through hinge.

Secure pin by inserting pin clip through small hole in pin.

Repeat on other end.


Tighten bolts securing hinges to bed, and then tighten bolts in ends of air bar.



#### Shock Installation

#### CAUTION

Remove retaining pins from ends of shocks (shown below). Lifting from center, raise canopy until shocks fit. Install shocks with small shaft DOWN, or damage will result. Install end of shock over ball stud, in end of bed. Insert pins back into shock ends, rotating to lock.





#### Skirt Kit Installation


Slide in end cover (A) until flange is under tip of leg.

Repeat for other end.


Move front skirt (B) bottom in under leg, then push top in behind locking rib on bed.









#### Wiring diagrams for ballasts. Your tanning bed may have one or both types.
