

Phoneme K initial- 1 CVC one syllable



Kim kissed the **cat call**ed Fluffy. The cat was very **kind**.




Phoneme K initial- 2 CVC one syllable


Phoneme K initial- 3 CVC one syllable


Phoneme K initial-4 CVC one syllable


Phoneme K initial- 1 CVCe one syllable



Kate and Kade flew the kite to the cove of the cave on the beach.




Phoneme K initial - 2 CVCe one syllable


Phoneme K initial-<u>3</u> CVCe one syllable






Phoneme K initial-4 CVCe one syllable


Phoneme K initial- 1 CVVC One Syllable



The **cook** won't need a **coat**. It's a **clear** and sunny day and she will want to **keep cool**.




Phoneme K initial- 2 CVVC One Syllable


Phoneme K initial- 3 CVVC One Syllable

Phoneme K initial- 4 CVVC One Syllable




