

I went to work in my kitchen and whipped up a delicious homemade guacamole. Santa and his Little Helpers fa-la-loved it so much, they were singing my praises! This yummy Yuletide treat is filled with bits of red and green and is as pretty as a Christmas tree! Serve some of this delicious guacamole with your favorite tortilla chips at your next Christmas gathering and you're sure to have a house full of holly jolly little elves!

Ingredients:

- 3 medium avocados
- 3 plum tomatoes seeded and diced
- 1/2 small red onion diced
- 2 small jalpeno peppers seeded and diced
- 1/2 c fresh cilantro chopped
- 1 tbs. lime juice

Kosher salt to taste

In a mixing bowl smash avocados with a fork until slightly chunky. Add lime juice and mix until just creamy. Add diced tomatoes, red onion, jalpeno pepper, and chopped cilantro. Mix well. Add salt to taste. Chill for one hour in an airtight container. Serve with your favorite tortilla chips. Enjoy!
