
IMPORTANT! For Commander X Models:


Dissconnect Front Sway Bar from Lower A-Arms before beginning installation. Reconnect when installation is complete and machine is on ground.


- Keep all components removed from machine.
- Do not tighten hardware completely unless noted.

Front Installation:

- 1. Raise front of machine off ground, secure with jack stands, and remove Wheels.
- Disconnect end of Air Hose as shown in Fig. 1.
- 2. Install Bracket, Passenger (A) to Frame with M6-1.0 x 25mm Lg. HHCS, M6 Washers, and M6-1.0 Nylock Nut. See Fig. 2.
- Use stock Shock hardware to secure Bracket to stock Shock mounting hole in Frame. See Fig. 2.
- Complete installation of Bracket, Passenger (A) with M8-1.25 x 25mm Lg. HHCS, M8 Washer, and M8-1.25 Nylock Nut. See Fig. 2a.
- Repeat steps for opposite side.
- 3. Install Shocks to Brackets (A)(B) with M10-1.50 x 55mm Lg. HHCS and M10-1.50 Nylock Nuts. See Fig. 2.
- 4. Tighten all hardware completely. Reinstall Wheels.









Rear Installation:


- 1. Raise Cargo Box and remove Bed Stops.
- Raise rear off ground; secure with jack stands.
- Remove Wheels.
- Remove Shocks from Shock Mounts.
- 2. Install Clip Nuts into stock Shock Mounts. See Figs. 3 3b.
- 3. Install Rear Shock Brackets (C) to stock Shock Mounts with M8-1.25 x 25mm Lg. HHCS. See Figs. 3 3b.
- Use M10-1.50 x 65mm Lg. HHCS and M10-1.50 Nylock Nuts to secure Rear Shock Brackets (C) to stock Shock mounting hole See Figs. 3 - 3b.
- 4. Reinstall Bed Stops. See Fig. 4.
- Install Shocks to Rear Shock Brackets (C) with M10-1.50 x 70mm Lg. HHCS and M10-1.50 Nylock Nuts. See Fig. 4.
- 2014+ years will require Differential Vent Tube rerouting. Reroute and secure to Rear Bracket (C). See last page of instructions.
- 7. Tighten all hardware completely. Reinstall Wheels.







