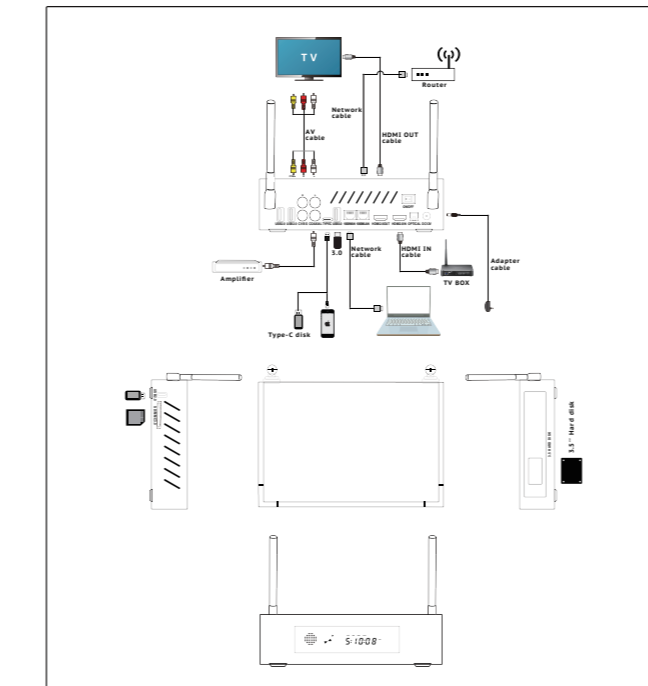

User can select corresponding connectors to connect with TV according their different requirement.

HDMI connection

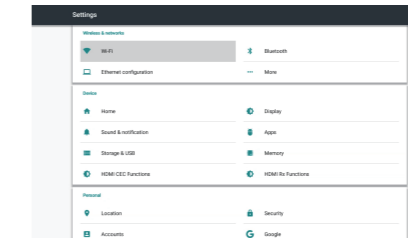
- Connect with TV via HDMI output: Use the HDMI cable to connect between player HDMI port and TV HDMI port. At same time, set TV input mode to HDMI.
- Set the TV Output display settings to 720P or 1080P and then transferred to the corresponding TV HDMI Component Video status.

A/V connection

Connect with TV via AV cable: Use the AV cable to connect between player AV port and TV AV port. At same time, set TV input mode to AV.

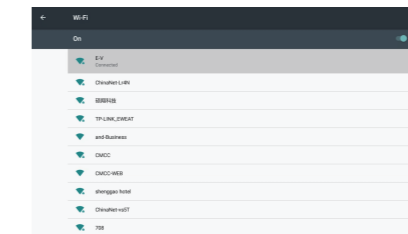
Settings

Move to "Settings" icon; press ok to enter into system settings. Or press on the remote control. You will see the menu on the following picture.



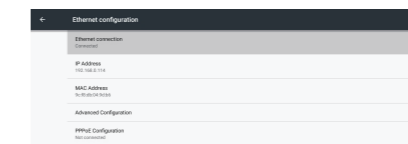
Wi-Fi

With Wi-Fi enabled, you will need to click on your network' s name and enter the password. An on screen keyboard should appear if you' re using the standard infrared remote control.



Ethernet

If you will use a network cable instead of Wi-Fi, please select this option instead.



Troubleshooting

Warning

Problem	Solution
No signal on the TV	1) Check if the HDMI or AV cable is securely connected. 2) Check if you have selected the correct input source on the TV.
Cannot turn on your media player	1) Check if the power connector is completely plugged into the DC socket of your media player. 2) Check if the power supply is stable.
Cannot connect to network	1) Make sure that the network cable is securely connected and the Ethernet works well. 2) Make sure that WiFi network is connected and the security key for the encrypted network is correct. 3) Make sure that you select the correct IP address settings.
Remote control does not respond	1) Make sure that the batteries are good. 2) Make sure that the distance between the remote control and your media player is no longer than 12 meters.
Some TV cannot display entire screen	Setup the screen display position of your media player.Used the zoom key on the remote control to select it.
