Have customers who need an extra nudge to buy that solar PV system from you?

With Green Tags, photovoltaic solar just got more affordable.

How?

The Northwest Solar Cooperative has teamed with the Bonneville Environmental Foundation (BEF) to launch Solar Starters – a unique program that allows participating small-scale PV installations to earn 10 cents per kWh for every kWh produced and net-metered back into the energy grid.

Systems are eligible for 5 years and annual payments begin to accrue as soon as a contract is signed and the solar system starts generating energy.

Average customers may receive \$1000 over the life of the program on a 2 kW system – think of it as an environmental rebate for increasing the amount of solar energy delivered into our collective energy grid.

Who's Eligible?

All grid-tied PV solar system owners with systems installed in Oregon or Washington after June 1, 2002.

Enrollment is Easy:

- Step 1 Customers purchase and install a grid-tied photovoltaic solar system. (Systems must include a kilowatt-hour meter which measures the AC output of the power inverter.)
- Step 2 Customer contacts Doug Boleyn of the Northwest Solar Co-operative and signs up with Solar Starters: (503) 655-1617 or cascadesolar@attbi.com.
- **Step 3** Customers start earning an annual payment for adding solar energy to the power grid.
