PORTABLE BASKETBALL GOAL

FRAME

The base is fabricated from 14-gauge sheet steel and coated with a durable white powder coat finish. The support post is heavy-wall 3-1/2" square tubing with a zinc-plated inner post that is spring loaded for easy adjustment. Unit adjusts from 6'-6" to 10'-0" and has a boom extension of 4'-2".

BALLAST

Empty weight of goal support is 383 lbs. Gross weight of the unit, including the minimum 300 lbs. of ballast, is 683 lbs. The preferred ballast material is patio blocks and is not included with the unit.

WHEELS

Each unit has 6" diameter wheels on the rear and 4" diameter swivel castors on the front. All wheels have a polyurethane surface.

PADDING

The front of each unit is padded with 1" polyurethane foam covered by 14-ounce vinyl.

BACKBOARD AND GOAL

GP5432 Board Assy, 32" x 54" x 3/8" Acrylic Model 724 Titan Plus Breakaway Goal

A unitized welded frame shall be constructed with (2) 1/8" thick aluminum angle struts and a 1/8" aluminum formed channel section to reinforce the area for the direct goal attachment. The backboard shall be framed with 1/8" thick formed aluminum angle sections joined at the corners by steel brackets. The backboard surface shall be constructed of 3/8" thick clear acrylic treated for UV protection, and abrasion resistance. White target lines shall be screened onto the back side of the board surface. Vinyl cushion tape shall be used between the aluminum frame members and the acrylic surfaces. Goal mounts on a 4h x 3w & 4h x 5w pattern and fits models 26WO, 39WO, 724, 726, & 1000.
