



Install Your Batteries

1A. Place the Green AA Rechargeable Batteries in the compartment on the bottom of the base unit. Check the picture for correct orientation.

1B. Turn ON/OFF switch to ON. You will hear the announcement "Running on Battery Power." Unit will do so until the AC Adapter power supply is plugged in.



RED Light = Charging
GREEN Light = Battery Charged

No Light = Defective battery or no battery installed

1C. The battery door can be opened by sliding the latch at the bottom of the pendant all the way to the right. Pull open the hinged door and place the battery with the silver end facing up. Next, close the door and slide the latch back to the left. If installed properly, the pendant will make an announcement that the battery is ok.

1D. If this is the first two-way voice pendant you are adding to your CaretakerSentry, you will need to add your replacement battery to the base station's charging port. To add the replacement battery, slide open the battery door and place the battery in with the silver end facing left.





Plug Telephone Line and Power Cord into Wall Jacks



2A. Plug the AC Adapter power cord into the power jack and twist 1/4 turn clockwise to lock.

Next, plug the AC Adapter into an electrical socket.

2C. (OPTIONAL) Plug the telephone into the "To House Phone" jack.

2B. Plug the telephone cord into the wall phone jack.



Test the Unit

Perform a System Test



3A. Push the GRAY test button on back of pendant for **4 seconds**3B. Listen for voice prompt from base unit:


i. If the system is correctly installed, "All Systems are OK – Battery is OK" is heard.

ii. If any other voice prompt is heard, the unit will describe the problem.

3C. We recommend that you perform this System Test weekly.

Place call to Emergency Operator:

answer the call.



3F. Talk normally into the pendant–just like into a speaker phone.

3G. At the end of the conversation, the CaretakerSentry should automatically hang up. If it does not hang up, push the CANCEL button for 1 second (either on back of pendant or on base unit.)
