

Which third-party cameras are compatible?

Alarm.com can integrate with third-party cameras that meet the following requirements.

Important: The customer account will need a *Commercial Video* or *Commercial Video Plus* service package, or one of the legacy Commercial Video 4/8/16 service packages with the *Third Party Cameras* add-on, to utilize third-party devices. Third-party camera model requirements

Communication Protocol	Onvif Profile S or VAPIX user enabled
IP Protocol	When cameras are downstream from CSVN: • DHCP When cameras are upstream from CSVN: • DHCP or static IP
Compression	H.264
Camera Communication Type	Ethernet (Wired)

Note: Third-party devices are compatible with the ADC-SVR210 and the 20XXP and 21XXP Pro Series CSVNs.
